Project Location

On 10th April 2018, I held a meeting with the people of Kirongero 'A' for start of the excavation of shallow well in their area. The parish of Kirongero has approximately 6894 people and Kirongero 'A' as a village has 1428 people.

The area is a rocky hence hindering the surface water to stay long for use by the people. Therefore, they mostly use boreholes that are located apart from one another. The only surface they had at Walumbe was turned into a burial ground by the government hindering them from access to good water. The members claim that they can't use the water as it's near the cemetery. Therefore, the arrangement by New Apostolic Church has saved them.

The location of the place where the shallow well is being dug was agreed on by all the community who are beneficiaries.

The chairman of the Local Council area, Mr. Balaba Francis (+256 784 027 848 / +256 759 351 140) emphasized that, the shallow well that is going to be dug be kept hygienically clean to fight water bone diseases. He gave an example that people tend not to wash their hands after vising latrines and end up on the wells to drink water using their hands and in turn many diseases have affected them.

According to the chairman, the beneficiaries are expected to be about 320 people including some schools, people of different denominations etc.
